For International Students

Congratulations! You've made the decision to begin your aviation career at FlightSafety Academy. Detailed information is included below about starting your training at FlightSafety.

Prospective students must submit a \$150.00 Application Fee and \$2,350.00 Tuition Deposit in order to confirm a position in the selected class and for placement on a space-available list for on campus housing accommodations.

Students must meet the FAA minimum age requirements for each certificate sought. Applications may be submitted online at www.flightsafetyacademy.com, by email at academy@flightsafety.com, by fax at 772-564.7660 or by mail at 2805 Airport Drive Vero Beach, FL 32960 to the attention of Admissions.

International Student Application Requirements

To apply to FlightSafety Academy, please submit the following application requirements in English:

- **Application for Admissions**
 - Must be signed and completed in its entirety
- **\$150.00 Non-Refundable Application Fee**
- **\$2,350.00 Refundable Tuition Deposit**
- **Copy of FAA 1st Class and Student Pilot Medical Certificate**
 - Find an FAA Medical Examiner at www.faa.gov or www.flightphysical.com
 - Note: Please ensure that your full legal name and correct birthday are written on the 1st Class Medical and that the option for Student Pilot Certificate is checked on the medical application.
 - If the student is unable to obtain the certificates prior to arrival at the academy and enrollment in the ground portion of the course, the student must obtain the certificates prior to the start of the flight training portion of the course.
- **Proof of Education**
 - High School Transcript/Diploma, G.E.D. or College Transcript/Diploma. The credential for all international student's secondary education is to be translated and certified to be at least equivalent to a U.S. high school diploma. Documents can be certified through a member of www.naces.org/members.html
- **Proof of English Proficiency**
 - TOEFL score of 550 for written exam, 213 for computer exam or 80 for IBT / www.TOEFL.org
 - Alternate English proficiency examinations can be submitted for consideration
- **Copy of Passport**
- **Copy of Student Pilot/Flight Certificates (if any held)**
 - For all licenses issued outside of the U.S., a Foreign License Verification is required. Please refer to Foreign License Verification Guide for complete information.
- **Student Review Form (if hold Private Pilot License or above)**
- **TSA Registration at www.flightschoolcandidates.gov**
 - Please refer to TSA Guide fact sheet for assistance
- **Proof of Financial Ability**
 - Students must provide a Bank Letter which states the amount of funds available to cover both the tuition and living expenses in U.S. dollars. Please refer to Bank Letter fact sheet for assistance.
